GUIDELINES FOR PAPER SUBMISSION

- **Abstract with short bio and contact information in application form** for Global Climate Change, Environment and Energy III. International Symposium should be sent to ces2022@aydin.edu.tr by **1 April 2022**.
- Each symposium abstract submission applicant must provide **only one e-mail address**.
- Review of abstracts will be completed by **1 May 2022** and notifications to accepted abstract submitters will be sent to the e-mails provided in their application forms.
- Symposium Program will be announced on **1 May 2022** at web page.
- Full papers should be sent to ces2022@aydin.edu.tr by **1 July 2022**.
- Abstracts and papers should be in **Turkish or English**.
- Abstracts should be between **150-300 words** and sent with a short bio, both should be typed in **Word document, The Times New Roman 12 font-1.5 space**.
- Full papers should not exceed **15 pages**. Papers should include **Turkish/English abstract, keywords and Bibliography**.
- In references and bibliography, **APA style** should be used.
- In sessions, paper presentations will be limited to **15 minutes**.
- Selected papers will be published in IJEMME journal and as an edited book.
